Information on Winery & Wines.

Situation

Terre des Dames, formerly Mas des Dames, is a select winery that Jancis Robinson classed in the Financial Times amongst her 'Languedoc favorites'. Run since 2002 by Dutch woman Lidewij van Wilgen, the wines are increasingly gaining reputation.



The heart of the winery is the house from 1750 surrounded by small vineyards on different levels. An exceptional geological situation supplies underground water even in the hottest season, giving the wines a freshness that is quite unique for the region.

All production is organic. *All* grapes are picked by hand and selected on a sorting table.

The wines

Terre des Dames – La Dame 2015 AOC Coteaux Languedoc

Grenache, Carignan, Syrah (50/30/20%)

The main reference of Terre des Dames. A typical Languedoc for its fruit and concentration. A-typical however for its freshness and soft tannins.

Terre des Dames – La Diva 2014
Vin de Pays des Coteaux de Murviel

The originality of this wine comes from its assemblage: Syrah and Grenache (from our best AOC plots, 50/30%) with Alicante, coming from 100-years old grapevines, giving no more than 15 hl/ha. La Diva is a deep, supple red with an attractive complexity that improves with aging. Aged in barrel (big volume, finest French oak) for at least 12 months. Decanter 2015: Silver medal. Winespectator 2015 90/100

Terre des Dames – Le Blanc 2017
VdPays d'Oc

A rare 100% white Grenache, coming from a plot with fossilised oysters. Unusual mineral notes and a long lasting, refreshing quality. 50% aged in 500 l barrels of French oak, adding a subtle additional complexity. Terre des Dames – La Diva Blanche 2016
VdPays d'Oc

The grapes of the older vineyards were vinified separately and aged in a 600 L barrel made following a secret procedure of our barrel-maker. 'Trust me', he just said. The result was so outstanding, that we bottled this wine separately. Total production : 800 bottles. Can easily age for five more years.

Terre des Dames – Diva Rosé 2017
AOC Languedoc

Mouvèdre, Grenache, Syrah (50/30/20), direct pressing.
A refreshing, spicy and expressive rosé made from high quality grapes from old Grenache and Syrah combined with young Mouvèdre. Subtle aging in barrel for more complexity. Great with food.
